Introduction



Eastern tip of Ontario

- 3 lower-tier municipalities in the
 United Counties of Prescott and Russell
- Joint recycling committee operated collection prior to transition
- Were NOT servicing ICI / non-eligible



Introduction

- Opted out as of July 1st, 2023
- CMO chose local contractors
- Each municipality now has separate contractors



First Impressions

VERY smooth transition



Pre-transition Concerns

Local MRF

- MRF
 Material Receiving
 Facility
- Our local MRF, Recycle-Action, was too small to bid on CMO's contract

Mixed-Use properties

- BIA Lack of recycling service has been a source of confusion to commercial tenants for years
- Worry surrounding potential lapse of service for residential portions of these mixed-use properties

Non-Eligibles

- ICI

 Industrial
 Commercial
 Institutional
- Institutional includes municipal buildings



What Worked Well

- NO issues from our mixed-use properties
 - Still waiting to see how this may evolve
- Contractors know the routes
- Fielding complaints is EASY now




What Didn't Work Well

- Some collection runs changed routes slight timing adjustment for residents
- Adding eligible addresses work in progress
- Loss of local MRF Sorting facility closes September 30th
- Ongoing planning of a separate service for non-eligibles
 - NO private contractors in our area
 - NO other MRFs in our area increase in transportation
 - Loss of economies of scale



Comparative Costs



- Estimated costs for a separate recycling service are ~ 15x the cost of the grouped service
- Non-eligibles represent ~ 10% of our total units previously serviced for recycling while still being spread over the same 452 square kilometers.
 - Just the tipping fees for recycling are double those for garbage.

Classify your ICI properties Inform all non-eligible stakeholders of the transition Back-up options - Contractors and MRFs

Do so BEFORE the contractor signs with CMO

- Establish a sustainable recycling collection for our municipal buildings
- Continue considering creative solutions for our small businesses' recycling

Organics?

- Establishing yard waste collections
- Exploring options to help our residents divert organic waste
- Looking to our neighbours rolling out SSO shortly

Other waste diversion

- Joint Recycling Committee will continue operating a HHW event
- Promotion & education of the vast recycling options for HSP
- Promote the producer responsibility model to residents – Illustrate the shift in financial burden
